A daughter and granddaughter of painters, Caline de Gasquet was born and raised in the French countryside near Aix-en-Provence...the fragrant, color-drenched region that Cezanne lovingly rendered in dozens of paintings. Caline spent the first years of her career creating fabrics for home decorations, bed linen and children's clothing produced by several major French companies. For the next several years Caline's life transported her to Africa, Tahiti and New Caledonia. Living in these exotic environments provided the extraordinary visual stimulation, the native peoples, the bright colors, and the vivid natural surroundings that inspired her to have a naive freshness rendered with a Matisse-like approach, preferring to often work on large canvasses. She reaches beyond the reality of the subject before her, putting her personal interpretation and "joie de vivre" into what she is painting.
